

Milestone Ministries

Milestone Ministries provide a faith milestone as a marker along life's journey that says, "This is important, and God is here too." It is a faith formation practice for both families and the congregation to recognize God's presence in everyday life. Middle School Ministry

Confirmation is a time of learning the Bible, connecting with others, and sharing the good news of Jesus Christ! We know your family has taught you to pray, given you God's blessing, and brought you to worship. Now in confirmation, you will be bringing all that you have learned so far, and together we will be opening the Bible, learning the Small Catechism, and trusting in the promises of Jesus Christ.

Middle School Events are a time of fellowship and making new friends through activities, food, and conversations.

Goals for Confirmation

- A deep, living faith in Jesus Christ through hearing God's word
- A solid connection with God's people
- An ability to give the good news of Jesus Christ in word and deed



Guiding Principles

- Baptism, not confirmation, is the claiming grace of God for all of God's children.
- Confirmation is an affirmation of God's promise into a deeper and fuller participation in a life of community-shared faith and work.
- Pastors' involvement in teaching and interacting is essential.
- The home must be given the opportunity and responsibility to be an active partner in nurturing the faith of baptized children.
- Adults involved in confirmation ministry are called to be shepherds and mentors for those under their care.
- The foundational elements of the Lutheran church and the Biblical story must be clearly taught and learned.

Worship Participation

- Attend worship weekly on Saturday or Sunday.
- Attend Wednesday Advent and Lenten worship services at 6:30 p.m.
- Fill out a Worship Reflection. One monthly worship reflection is the **minimum** expectation. Online form available at flcsf.org/youth.

Youth Group Participation

- Attend Youth Group. Attendance will be taken. If you're going to miss, please contact the Y&F staff.
- Youth are also are required to write a Faith Statement and submit a Faith Photo Project. In the summer after 9th grade, you will have an interview with a pastor to discuss your Faith Statement.

⇒ A retreat on March 10, 2024, will be focused to help you complete your Faith Statement.

Serving

Weekly Communion Servers: All students will be assigned to assist with communion clean-up and serving. (If the Saturday 5 p.m. service is better for you, we can make that work.) *Training will be provided.*


Information

Parking Lot Safety
